
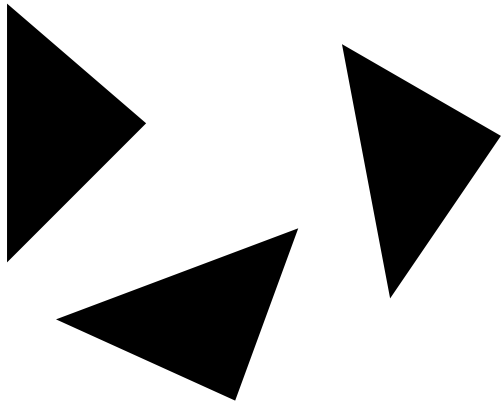


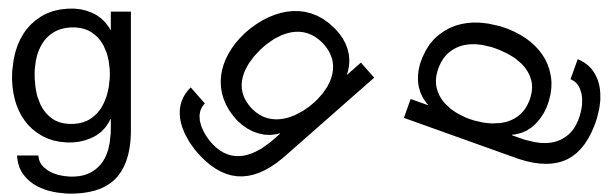
## Activity: Rotate Tool

- Click on your shape with the Move Tool to select it.
- Click on the Rotate Tool. 
- You may now spin your shape. Notice that the shape rotates around the anchor point in the center of the shape.
- With the rotate tool selected you can move the position of the anchor point.



The anchor point is the baseline of the letter.

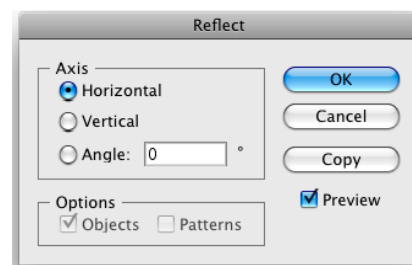
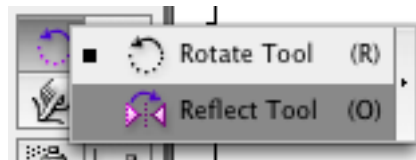
Type > Create Outlines changes the anchor point to the center.



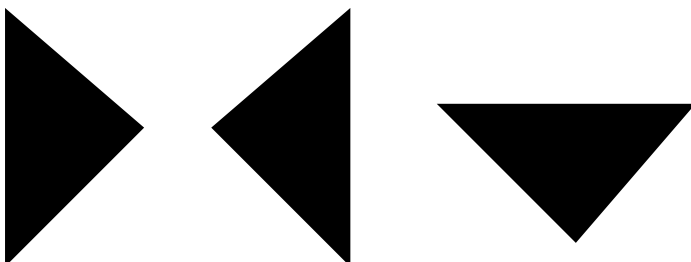
The letter "g" from Helvetica Neue.

## Activity: Reflect Tool

- Click on your shape with the Move Tool to select it.
- Choose the Reflect Tool. It is on the fly-out menu with the Rotate Tool on the Toolbar.
- Double-click on the Reflect Tool on the Toolbar and a pop-up palette will appear.

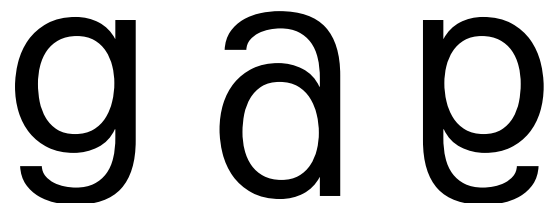


- Choose an Axis. If you have Preview selected you will see the result of your Reflect choice before you click OK.
